GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The Environmental Technician will assist with Environmental projects until September 30, 2019. Position may possibly be extended. Projects include: baseline water quality data collection; beach monitoring for debris; research composting and food waste assessment; and conducting outreach on woodstoves and clean burning practices program. Training on sampling protocols will be provided.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist with pre-field and post-field organizing for water quality sampling, including meter calibration, filling out appropriate paperwork, field and sample gear maintenance
- Collect weekly ocean water and biweekly shellfish samples to test for bio toxins and pH levels
- Assist in data analysis and writing reports
- Assist with researching food waste assessments and develop community program
- Assist with monitoring the compost bin at the community garden
- Conduct community outreach on environmental projects
- Travel by boat and small plane
- Attend and participate in YTT staff meetings and events
- Other duties as assigned
