HOURS: Part-time/ Seasonal (September – May)

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Tlingit Language Assistant Teachers will be hired to help the Lead Teacher organize, develop and implement language curriculum. The Assistant Teachers will work one prep hour before class each day and during classroom hours with students. The Assistant Teachers will study the language for review of accuracy of curriculum content and cultural relevancy. Monday-Friday, 5 hours a day, 3 hours in class and 2 of study/prep.

DUTIES:

1. Be self-motivated to fulfill the objectives of this position and grant;
2. Work in teams;
3. Study the Tlingit language at least once a day to further proficiency and review accuracy of curriculum content and cultural relevancy;
4. Be committed to learning, understanding and speaking the Tlingit language;
5. Will participate in all Tlingit Language Dinner Socials with families;
6. Participate in 3 immersion regional retreats per year to acquire Tlingit language through immersion and to learn immersion techniques;
7. Begin to pursuit Child Development Associates degree.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be at least 16 years of age.
