# GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The Fisheries Biologist will help YTT develop capacity to take an informed and active role in federal subsistence management through monitoring, data collection and participating in management processes. The Situk River is a prominent salmon producing river that has historically been one of the most productive rivers in Alaska, yet has experienced drastic declines in recent years. The Fisheries Biologist will work closely with the USFS Yakutat Ranger District on the Situk River Rangers program to promote culturally relevant outreach to river users, monitoring salmon runs, and conducting biological assessments. The Biologist's primary focus will be on the Situk River but the incumbent will identify other priority areas and projects that serve tribal members' subsistence needs.
