UPDATE COVID-19 TEST REPORTS 12/16/2020 2 (Two) CURRENT YAKUTAT ACTIVE POSITIVE COVID-19

Yakutat Covid-19 IC received confirmation from Yakutat Community Health Center there are 2 (Two) Active Covid-19 case as of 12/16/2020. YCHC reported the 2 (Two) 12/14/2020 added A-Symptomatic Persons are Negative. The State informed YCHC there was a reporting error between the testing lab and State Reporting System. The 12/09/2020 reported 2 (Two) Positive Individuals are Positive but will be completing their Isolation Period in a couple of days. The IC would like to thank everyone that has complied with the recently reported Covid-19 Standards set by the CDC during this time of confusion.

The IC and YCHC requests the Community and those Individuals Traveling take extra precautions. Individuals should pay close attention to their surroundings, limit your exposures, carry alcohol wipes for cleaning grocery carriages push bars, wiping the door handles, etc... limiting touching items and their face, use glove when appropriate, wear a mask and wash your hands frequently.

As the winter season is upon us so is the Flu Season so the IC and YCHC is reminding everyone Currently a large majority of the Statewide Covid-19 spread starts as Communal Spread; resulting in several other being infected by the Positive Person having direct contact with others. The IC asks that you take extra precautions to make your personal contact bubble smaller.

If anyone is showing signs and symptoms of Covid 19 self-quarantine and call the YCHC Covid Hotline 784-3010 or YCHC Business Line 784-3206 during hours, for directions. If you need immediate medical attention please call 911, state your emergency and inform the person that it may be Covid related. Any person that is positive or a direct contact of a Covid-19 positive: WILL BE REQUIRED TO FOLLOW THE CDC & STATE OF ALASKA GUIDELINES. TESTING AND QUARANTINE UNTIL RESULTS OR SELF QUARATINE FOR UP TO 14 DAYS or any other guideline requiring a longer isolation. You can find information at <u>covid19@alaska.gov</u>.
