## UPDATE COVID-19 TEST REPORTS 12/24/2020 1 (One) CURRENT YAKUTAT ACTIVE POSITIVE COVID-19

Yakutat Covid-19 IC received confirmation from Yakutat Community Health Center there is 1 (One) Active Covid-19 case as of 12/24/2020. YCHC reported the Positive Asymptomatic Person was tested on 12/23/2020. YCHC and the IC would like to thank everyone who has complied with the Covid-19 Standards set by the CDC & STATE. The Positive Reported Covid-19 Person has gone public and is requesting anyone that has had contact to be tested and self-quarantine.

The IC and YCHC requests the Community and those Individuals Traveling take extra precautions. Individuals should pay close attention to their surroundings, limit your exposures, carry alcohol wipes for cleaning grocery carriages push bars, wiping the door handles, etc... limiting touching items and their face, use glove when appropriate, wear a mask and wash your hands frequently.

As the winter season is upon us so is the Flu Season so the IC and YCHC is reminding everyone Currently a large majority of the Statewide Covid-19 spread starts as Communal Spread; resulting in several other being infected by the Positive Person having direct contact with others. The IC asks that you take extra precautions to make your personal contact bubble smaller.

## YCHC RECEIVED 100 DOSES OF MODERNA VACCINE MEDICAL STAFF & FIRST RESPONDERS ARE RECEIVING VACINATIONS NOW. AS YCHC RECEIVES MORE VACCINES THEY WILL BE SCHEDULING THE ELDERLY, PERSONS WITH UNDERLINING MEDICAL & THOSE CONSIDERED HIGHER RISK SOON.

If you need immediate medical attention please call 911, state your emergency and inform the person that it may be Covid related. Any person that is positive or a direct contact of a Covid-19 positive: WILL BE REQUIRED TO FOLLOW THE CDC & STATE OF ALASKA GUIDELINES. TESTING AND QUARANTINE UNTIL RESULTS OR SELF QUARATINE FOR UP TO 14 DAYS or any other guideline requiring a longer isolation. You can find information at covid19@alaska.gov.
