1 (One) CURRENT YAKUTAT ACTIVE POSITIVE COVID-19

Yakutat Covid-19 IC received confirmation from Yakutat Community Health Center there is **1 (One) Active Covid-19 case as of 12/29/2020**. YCHC reported the **Positive Person was tested on 12/27/2020 and is Symptomatic, this is in relation to travel**. *This case has been verified by YCHC COVID Staff. YCHC is taking extra steps and have implemented extra processes to verify the information from the different State of Alaska agencies involved with reporting in response to the clerical errors in regards to misinformation previously.*

**If you have been notified by the State of Alaska, please contact the YCHC Covid Manager, Martha Mallott 907-784-3010 to verify, prior to going public with your results.*

The IC and YCHC requests the Community and those Individuals Traveling take extra precautions. As the winter season is upon us so is the Flu Season so the IC and YCHC is reminding everyone **Currently a large majority of the Statewide Covid-19 spread starts as Communal Spread; resulting in several other being infected by the Positive Person having direct contact with others.**

If anyone is showing signs and symptoms of Covid 19 self-quarantine and call the YCHC Covid Hotline 784-3010 during hours, for directions. If you need immediate medical attention please call 911, state your emergency and inform the person that it may be Covid related. Any person that is positive or a direct contact of a Covid-19 positive: **WILL BE REQUIRED TO FOLLOW THE CDC & STATE OF ALASKA GUIDELINES. TESTING AND QUARANTINE UNTIL RESULTS OR SELF QUARANTINE FOR UP TO 10 DAYS or any other guideline requiring a longer isolation.** You can find information at covid19@alaska.gov.
