## **POSITION SUMMARY**

The Culture Camp Food Sovereignty Instructor for Salmon will be responsible for attending planning meetings with Culture Camp Coordinator prior to the start of camp to prepare a supply list, go over safety for campers, setting up materials and workstation prior to classes, and instructing courses as discussed and scheduled.

## **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Meet with Culture Camp Team members prior to the start of camp to present a lesson plan proposal of subjects that will be covered and practical applications that will be instructed during camp sessions (e.g. paper, tracing paper, pencils etc.)
- Provide two one-hour sessions of instruction to campers on scheduled days.
- Educate youth on safety with sharp knives, pressure cookers, and handling small fires.
- Complete and submit a final report that summarizes the planned activity sessions, evaluates what worked well, details all problems encountered and suggests ways to improve the program.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Must be able to pass a background check (i.e. and must not have been convicted by any jurisdiction for abuse, neglect, or any other crime, including misdemeanors, that would pose a safety or health risk to others).
- Must be knowledgeable in preparing different traditional foods such as dry fish,
- Must be comfortable working with kids of all ages.
- Possession of good communication and organizational skills and the willingness to work as a team member is required.
- Must stay alcohol and drug free at all times during the Culture Camp.
